

## Merit Academy Back to School FAQ's

# What happens on the morning of the first day of school?

The first day opens with a ceremony. If you plan to attend the ceremony (approx. 30 min or so), it will start at approx. 8:10 on the football field (it takes some time to organize the students by class). Students will be on the field, parents on the bleachers (if you choose to come). If you simply drop off the students, it will follow the same drop off and times, including any students who bus.

# Will my student be able to eat breakfast on the first day of school?

Yes, students who choose the breakfast meal (paid by Proposition FF, for now)
 will eat in the Ursa Popina and then head to the football field for the opening day ceremony.

## • What time does drop-off begin?

Students who eat breakfast can be dropped off starting at 7:30 AT THE EARLIEST. Doors will NOT be open prior to that, and we will have a skeleton crew of staff between 7:30 and 7:40. For those who can wait, we suggest beginning drop off at 7:40. # • What time should we arrive for pick-up at the end of each school day?

- Due to the congestion during pick up and unfriendly emails we receive about that traffic, it is absolutely IMPERATIVE that we do not begin forming a pickup line until dismissal at 3:15. Students are in class until 3:15, so there is no movement in a car line before that. Please, do NOT arrive earlier, unless you are parking to personally pick up your children, or they have an appointment that day and need to be dismissed earlier. Parking is VERY limited at the end of the school day.
- Please make sure we are moving the traffic quickly and without issue. We will
  have several staff members to help guide the traffic proceedings, especially
  during the first week or two.
- Note: it is MUCH faster and without any wait if you pick up your child later in that pick up window (i.e. 3:20 or 3:25), <u>especially</u> if you have older students who do <u>not</u> have siblings in the School of Grammar.

#### When do we find out what house our students are in?

 Friday, August 22 is House Sorting Day! Depending on grade, they will be sorted in the morning before lunch. You will know thereafter what color they can wear on



Fridays for house days! More information is coming, including time of sorting for each grade.

## When is picture day?

- Picture day is Friday, August 29. Please keep an eye out for information on payment. We have professional photographers who take outdoor photos, and families can purchase the DIGITAL photo and then print whatever sizes/forms/amounts they wish.
- Homeschoolers and full-time students will be photographed. These are also used for the yearbook.
- Students can be OUT of uniform on this day, in uniform, or in house colors, whatever they choose, AS LONG AS they are within the boundaries of the uniform (i.e. no crop tops, spaghetti straps, inappropriate logos, tight pants, no leggings without skirts, etc)

## Can kids wear hoods/hats in the building?

 No. If your child cannot wear a hoodie without wearing the hood on their head in the building, they will not be allowed to wear a hoodie.

# How can I check my child's grades?

- You and your child can access their grades, including what assignments are missing, etc, through your parent and their student Infinite Campus portal. If you do not have access, yet, please reach out to Krystin White: kwhite@merit.academy, or call 719 686 2274.
- Many SOG classes use Class DoJo for updates and assignments, as well. Grades 3<sup>rd</sup> and older will have Google Classroom. Please watch for information coming from your child's teacher for this link
- SOL/SOR teachers use Google Classroom. Students are responsible to check Google Classroom if they are absent or forget their assignment at school.

# What if there is a snow day?

o Initial snow days or 2 hour delays will be "real" snow days, meaning no assignments will be posted. If we appear to be using quite a few days and need to go remote for snow days or 2 hour delays, then Upper School students and grades 3-5th will need to check Google Classroom for their assignments and check-in instructions from each of their teachers. SOG K-2<sup>nd</sup> grade students will bring a "snow day packet" home in the fall. Please save this in a secure spot for snow days. After teachers go through those packets, a new packet will be issued.

## What academic award ceremonies do we have?

 SOG students celebrate A or A/B honor roll students each quarter. The dates and times for these ceremonies will be posted in our newsletter that you will receive



each weekend, as well as on our school calendar listed on our home page:

Merit.Academy We also post on our Family Facebook page. Parents <u>must check</u>

<u>Infinite Campus</u> to see if their students have all A's or A's and B's to be eligible for this award.

Upper School students celebrate by GPA each semester. Grades included in this
calculation are Monday -Thursday grades only, as they are the academic/core
courses, and do include the M-Thurs enhancement. The ceremony is during
advisory (end of day) at the end of each semester, following the close of semester
grades.

## How is information communicated to families?

- Every week we send out a newsletter with dates, summaries, and upcoming events. Please make sure your emails are correct in your Infinite Campus portal AND you have selected that it is OK to send "general" information to that email.
- o SOG teachers email newsletters with summaries and upcoming activities
- SOL/R teachers post assignments and information to Google Classroom and often send summaries home to parents, at least monthly
- Student's grades are posted and updated weekly in Infinite Campus
- News and updates and announcements are posted on the Merit Academy Family Facebook page
- o Event dates are listed on the Merit Academy website homepage calendar
- Teachers will reach out if they notice students are failing or struggling, usually by email to start.



- o At times, there may be hardcopies of upcoming events sent home with students.

We also have MS (SOL) and HS (SOR) girls/boys track and cross country, as well as HS (SOR) boys basketball, varsity shooting team for SOR, and shooting club for SOG/SOL. Our SOL/SOR teams are competitive and often require tryouts, open gym, and expectations to participate at a competitive level.
  - We also have Landsharks (SOG) cross country and track. As we continue to grow, we will add more sports and more sport levels for our school.
